BACKGROUND

In 2022, TCTA relocated to a new office building, necessitating the installation of signage on the front and side of the premises to establish the organisation's presence and identity. However, on 7 November 2024, severe thunderstorms caused extensive damage to the signage, destroying its structure. Following a detailed assessment by the Facilities Team, it has been determined that the signage cannot be repaired and requires complete replacement.

Outdoor building signage is a critical asset that supports the organisation's visibility, professionalism, and public image. It is a key communication tool; stakeholders and visitors locate the organisation while reinforcing TCTA's brand identity. A prominently displayed and well-designed sign provide:

- Brand Recognition: Showcasing the organisation's logo and name, making it easily identifiable.
- Landmark Visibility: Acting as a reference point for clients and visitors, ensuring ease of access.
- Competitive Edge: Differentiating TCTA from surrounding organisations in a competitive environment.
- Impact of Damaged Signage

The destruction of the signage has created a significant gap in TCTA's external representation. This impacts:

- Professional Image: The absence of signage diminishes the organisation's public perception and credibility.
- Operational Clarity: Visitors, clients, and stakeholders may face difficulty identifying the building, leading to potential confusion.
- Brand Engagement: A lack of visible signage weakens brand reinforcement and engagement opportunities.

TCTA is looking to appoint a service provider to supply corporate branding.

Creating outdoor building signage requires attention to design, durability, visibility, and weather resistance.
